REGISTRATION

Register online at www.thefirstteeaiken.org. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Payment must be made at the time the application is submitted; unless the student is requesting a Fee scholarship. Returning members may pay the Annual Membership at any time during the year, prior to registering for a class. By doing so, they agree to register for a class and participate in it with 80% attendance or better. (Failure to do so results in payment in full for the membership of \$350.00.)
