Levels and Requirements:

Age 5-6 – Must be 5 prior to the start of the session.

Age 7-9 – Must be 7 prior to the start of the session.

Age 10-11 – 10 years old (or turn 10 within the session time frame).

Age 12-13 – 12 years old (or turn 12 within the session time frame).

14+ – 14 years old (or turn 14 within the session time frame).

ACE – 15+ years old and Coach Recommended.

Girls Golf – Ages 7 and up.

#GameonGolf - 5 years old and up. Open to individuals with special needs.

REGISTRATION

Register online at www.firstteeaiken.org. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Payment must be made at the time the application is submitted unless the student is requesting a Fee scholarship. Returning members may pay the Annual Membership at any time during the year, prior to registering for a class. By doing so, they agree to register for a class and participate in it with 80% attendance or better. (Failure to do so results in payment in full for the membership of \$350.00.)
